THE FOUNDER OF SANAUBAR MEETS WITH THE CHIEF OF THE ROYAL HASHEMITE COURT.

Ms. Malak Alamar, the founder of Sanaubar project, met with the Chief of the Royal Hashemite Court at the Jordanian house (the Royal Hashemite court) with a group of achievers youth across the kingdom. Ms. Malak praised His Majesty King Abdullah II for his support of the people in Gaza and for Jordan's honorable stance on the Palestinian cause. SANAUBAR BEGINS IMPLEMENTING THE FIRST SESSION OF ITS NEW PILOT PROJECT FOR WOMEN.

sanaubar has started its second pilot project titled "From Home to Home," targeting women passionate about farming from Al-Baqa'a Camp. The project provides them with the necessary skills and knowledge about modern agricultural techniques and organic farming, as well as its economic and social impacts on individuals and the community.

The project includes 15 women and encourages them to start their own home gardens in available spaces at their homes. They will grow various types of medicinal herbs, use them for their daily needs, and benefit from the surplus by producing organic food that can be sold and marketed later, providing an additional source of income.
